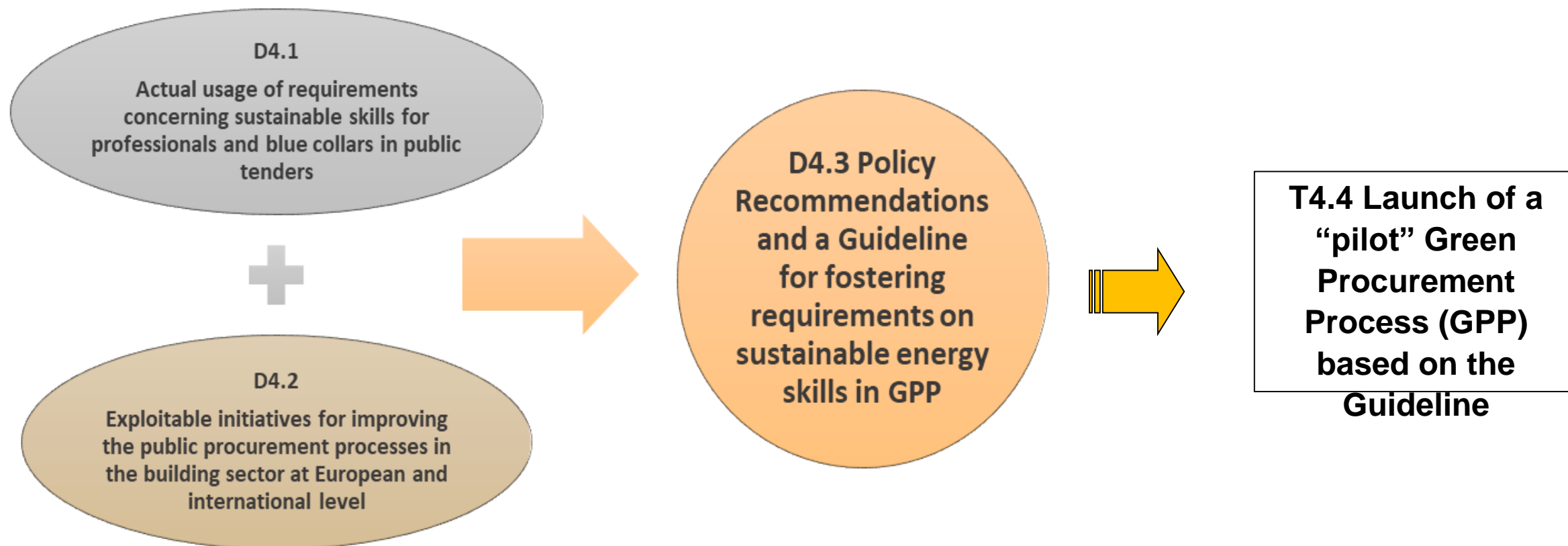

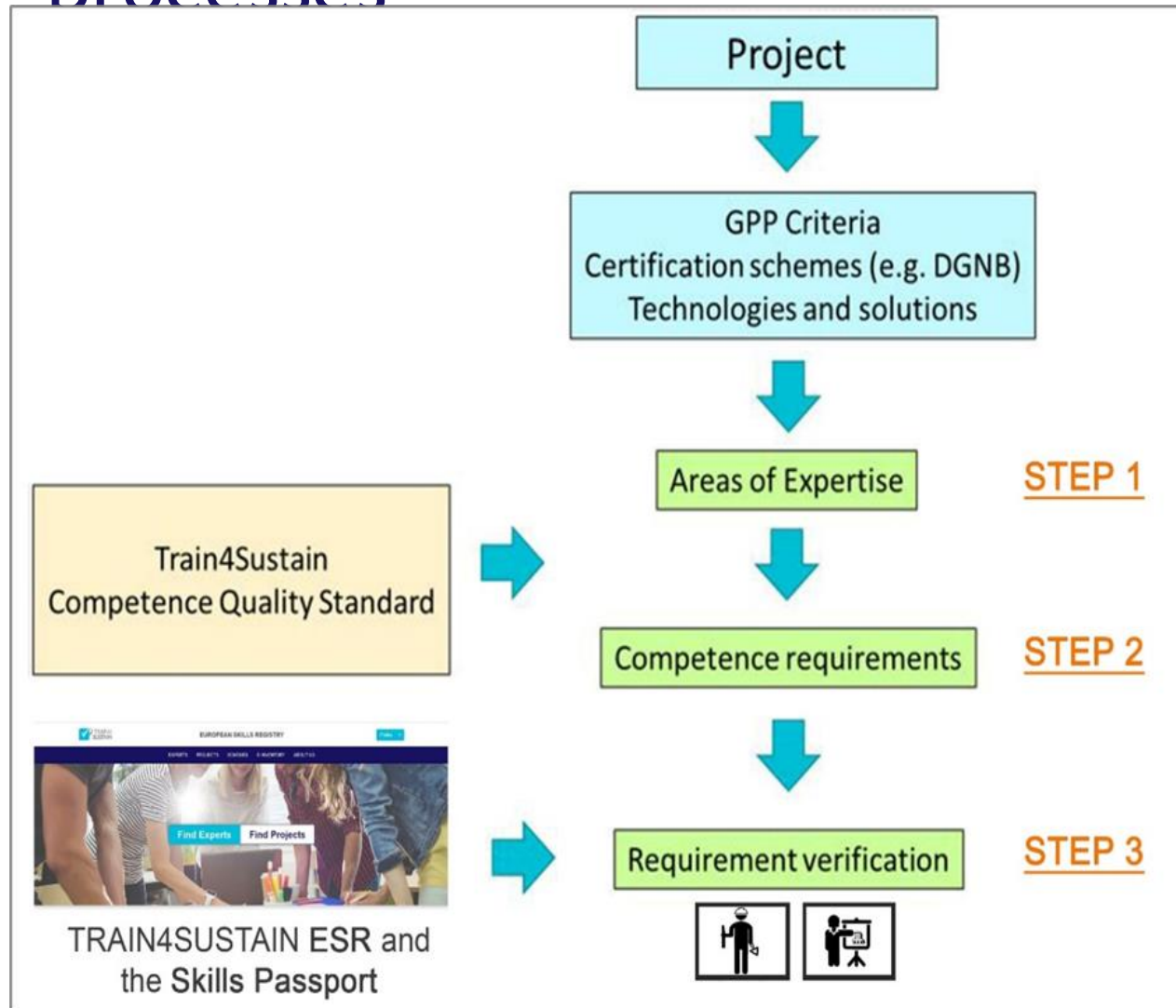

STEP 3: Verify the requested skills
