

TWG 2 Mutual Recognition

BUS EU exchange meeting 30-31 May 2017

- ▶ No one size fits all: (i) EU regulated, (ii) minimum requirements at EU level (driver license approach), (iii) standardized format for description of skills and knowledge.
- ▶ The key: transparency of qualification requirements - very important for free movement of workers;
- ▶ Dedicated call for creating European ULOs that are building blocks of qualification standards or equivalent;
- ▶ Qualification of craftsmen and other professionals must be incorporated in the procurement practices;
- ▶ ESF is using not enough funds on “green jobs” although it is part of priority axis 3 (Employment) - set % of ESF to be used for “green jobs” in construction sector;
- ▶ Develop more training programmes for training on-site and ensure its recognition;
- ▶ Continue in exchange meetings, as we have concrete topics for cooperation such as mutual recognition.
